

The Club Action Planning Scheme (CAPS) is a programme designed to captivate you and your netball club. It aims to support you to deliver a quality netball development programme and operate in line with best practice.

If you are interested in becoming a CAPS accredited club please contact the Regional office or your County Netball Development Officer for further details and support. The process is outlined on the next page.

BIG CAPS NEWS

In March 2017, CAPS went online. This has made the process of CAPS smoother, quicker and far more efficient. Going forward all new and reaccrediting clubs will go through the online system.

The CAPS Process



Steps to achieving CAPS

What help is available?

Step 1

Registration

Register your club for CAPS by completing the registration form and returning it to England Netball. You must have junior members (U19) and be affiliated to England netball

Download the form from www.EnglandNetball.co.uk/make-the-game/caps or contact your regional office

Step 2

Working towards CAPS

Actively work towards CAPS. You may want to form a working group to assist with completing the assessment file and collecting evidence.

Your Netball Development Officer (NDO) will contact you to arrange a meeting to go through the assessment file.

Step 3

Submission of file

Once you have completed the assessment file you need to submit this to your regional office by one of the assessment dates.

Achieve Bronze CAPS

Step 4

Annual Health Check

Once you have achieved CAPS you must complete an Annual Health Check each year of accreditation. This is a self-declaration process to ensure that clubs are maintaining CAPS status.

Your regional office will contact you when you need to complete your Annual Health Check and your NDO will assist you if you need help.

Step 5

Silver and Gold CAPS

Once you have achieved Bronze CAPS you have the option for going for Silver or Gold.

If you wish to submit for Silver or Gold CAPS contact your regional office who will advise and support your club.

Step 6

External Verification

Clubs are randomly selected each year to be externally verified by an independent organisation to ensure that they are meeting Clubmark standards.

If your club is selected you will be informed by England Netball and you will be contacted by ClubMark, the organisation responsible, to arrange a date and time that is convenient.

Step 7

CAPS Re-accreditation

Every four years CAPS clubs must re-accredit. This will involve re-submitting the assessment file.

Your regional office will contact you to tell you when you need to re-accredit and your NDO will be available to assist you with updating your assessment file.


New Places Leisure Centre at Eastleigh

Partners involved in the development of a brand new leisure centre in Eastleigh were invited to attend a preview of the facilities, which include a 3 netball court sports hall, full International run offs and spectator seating. As well as the indoor facilities, there are also 3 new outdoor netball courts. England Netball together with Netball South and Hampshire Netball have supported the project, with the intention of it being a Regional Netball Centre for the South. A capital grant of £90,000 has been awarded to Eastleigh Borough Council as a contribution to the overall costs of the Leisure Centre. This has ensured that the facilities built meet 'Premier' netball specifications, which according to an audit undertaken by England Netball in 2015, were lacking in the South Region.

The Centre opened to the public on Tuesday 28 November 2017.


