BURSARY APPLICATION



General Information

The aim of the Netball South Bursary is to support affiliated members with Continuous Professional Development (CPD). Netball South recognises that courses to achieve new qualifications can be costly and offers financial awards to support those who are involved in Netball throughout the South region.

Who can apply?

Any fully affiliated member to the South region can apply for a bursary.

Bursaries will be awarded to:

Affiliated Netball South members, towards costs for England Netball recognized coaching and umpiring awards. These can include;

- **UKCC Level 1, 2 and 3 Awards**
- **Umpire awards C, B and A**
- **Table Officials Award**
- **Tutor Training (ADL)**

Eligibility criteria?

- All applicants **must** be individually affiliated to Netball South
- Only one bursary per individual can be awarded per season.
- Bursaries can only be given for the cost of a course. Bursaries **will not** be awarded for travel costs or accommodation
- Application **must** be countersigned by the Chair, Vice Chair or Secretary of your Netball League Committee or County (See How do I Apply);
- Applications **must** be received 5 working days prior to the course start date.
- The committee **reserves the right to limit awards to any one club**. This will be determined by the volume of applications received in the financial year.

How much can I apply for?

Netball South bursaries will pay **up to 50%** of the total course cost to successful applicants.

How do I apply?

- Applicants will need to complete an official application form and return to Netball South at least 5 working days prior to the course date
- The Committee will only consider applications received 5 working days prior to the course start date.
- Application **must** be countersigned by the Chair, Vice Chair or Secretary of your Netball League Committee or County;

How are Bursaries assessed?

The Netball South regional management board will assess all applications made against the eligibility criteria and quality of information on the application form. The benefit of the course to the netball community in the South region will be considered together with the amount of funding available. Successful applicants will be expected to provide information how they intend to support Netball in the South.

Notification

Applicants will be notified as to the success of their application as soon as it is possible.

Any award will be paid by cheque to the applicant and sent to the address stated on the application form after proof of completing the course has been received.
